



State of Washington Department of Corrections Sole Source Posting November 7, 2016

The Department of Corrections (DOC) contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Status Automation to migrate our dated analog camera system into our current digital camera system and integrate it with the current door control and other security systems at the Stafford Creek Correction Center, Aberdeen, Washington.

Status Automation installed and has done maintenance for both systems. They are intimately familiar with the system and how it is embedded and integrates into our other security systems.

Status automation holds the maintenance contract for the systems has done so since 2008. They have performed application upgrades, hardware replacement for both door controls and camera systems at SCCC. They are familiar with this system and SCCC security protocols. Their high level of knowledge and expertise will permit the efficient integration and effective implementation planning with the facility thereby reducing operational impacts. More specifically as they are the current maintenance service provider, their ability to service and provide support in maintaining the upgraded system will be seamless.

The Purchase Order will be issued on or about November 23, 2016. The dollar value is estimated at \$196,000.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements by November 18, 2016. The following information should be included in the capability statements:

- Certification the vendor has working knowledge of both systems and the ability to do the work required, including OEM Application certifications.
- Vendor must provide an example of other systems they have upgraded and experience working in a correctional environment.
- Vendor's ability to be available for consulting and assistance in all testing, issue resolution, installation and repair.
- Vendor must be capable of offering ongoing maintenance and support contract for upgraded system.
- Vendor must be able to provide 24/7 emergency repair response.
- Vendor must be able to install OEM Application updates and revisions, and resolve integration/configuration discrepancies.

In the absence of other qualified sources, it is the state's intent to make a sole source award of the contract.
