

Driving Directions

From North I-5:

- Travel I-5 South and take the I-205 cutoff (just past Clark County Fairgrounds).
- Take exit 32 Padden Parkway. At light turn left. (East)
- Travel approximately 5 miles. Stay in left lane. (Road turns into one lane). You are now on NE Ward Road.
- Follow for 2-3 miles through a 4-way stop.
- Travel about 1 mile and turn right on 139th. You will go up a big hill, down through 4-way stop, and then up another hill. 139th road becomes NE Rawson Rd.
- Follow until you go through an open gate into the DNR Forestry Rd.

From the open gate follow the main road for approximately 2½ miles. At the top of the hill you will come to a 4-way intersection. Turn left going down the hill (approximately 2½ miles), Larch will be on your left at the bottom of the hill.

Leaving the institution:

- Turn right out of institution. Go up the hill to 4-way intersection turn right.
- Follow down to 4-way stop. Keep going straight through until you come to a T-intersection.
- Turn left. (NE Ward Rd.).
- Follow through 4-way stop. Road will turn into multiple lanes. Stay in right lane to get back to I-205.

Driving & Parking

- The speed limit on facility grounds is 15 mph. Thank you for not speeding.
- Designated visitor parking area is located in the lower parking lot just above the visiting area.
- Overflow parking is available to the right of the main institution entrance.
- Visitors will enter the grounds through the main institution entrance. Visitors will stop at the intercom and ring the call box stating they are at the facility for visitation. The staff answering the intercom will instruct the visitors to wait there or to park in the designated parking area.
- When you reach the visit check-in area, the officer there will ask for your current photo ID and process you into the computer.
- All visitor vehicles must be secured, locked and vacated while on state property.
- Under no circumstances will minors or pets be left in vehicles unattended, nor will vehicles be left running unattended for any reason.
- Cell phones, pagers, and other personal electronic devices are not allowed inside the facility and will be left in your secured vehicle.
- LCC is a non-smoking facility, cigarettes, lighters and other tobacco products are not allowed inside the facility and will be left in your secured vehicle.

Accessibility

- The control officer will direct visitors with state approved handicap parking permits to handicap accessible parking.
