- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received in this case.

Mr. Lovrick was seem for a .100 hearing at the Stafford Creek Corrections Center on May 15, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Lovrick is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Pierce County Cause 82-1-02342-8 Count I Murder in the First Degree and Count II Manslaughter in the First Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Lovrick committing the murder of a young co-worker and her unborn baby during a botched burglary attempt at a Safeway store where they both worked. Mr. Lovrick was 18 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 54 years of age.

Risk assessment scores take into consideration protective factors which give him a low to moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Lovrick has committed three serious infractions in 35 years.

Mr. Lovrick has completed several offender change programs to include Redemption/Re-entry Skills, Roots of Success, and Alternatives to Violence, Choices and Consequences, Stress Anger Management and has a current referral to Chemical Dependency treatment.

Mr. Lovrick appeared very remorseful during his hearing as well as humble.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Lovrick parolable from Count I to Count II of Pierce County Cause 82-1-02342-8 on April 28, 2020. The panel also finds him conditionally parolable to a mutual re-entry plan on Count II.
Next Action: Schedule .100 hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date on Count II.
