- Mr. Fagundes was seen for a .100 Hearing at the Cedar Creek Corrections Center on May 16, 2018

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Fagundes is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Snohomish County Cause 78-1-00403-7 for Murder in the First Degree Count IV. He has consecutive counts under this cause number for Taking a Motor Vehicle without Permission Count V and Theft in the First Degree Count VII.

The crimes involved Mr. Fagundes entering the home of a female neighbor who was 57 years of age. He kidnapped her using her own vehicle, drove to a secluded spot where he raped and murdered her. He returned to her

home and ransacked it stealing various items. He was 17 years of age at the time of these crimes and he is currently 57 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him at a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Fagundes committed his last serious infraction in 2000.

Mr Fagundes has completed recommended programming by the Board as well as a successful transition to lower levels of custody.

Mr. Fagundes takes responsibility for his crime. He has community support and a good transition plan.

- **Recommendation:** The panel finds Mr. Fagundes parolable to Counts V and VII of Snohomish County Cause 78-1-00403-7.
