- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Rivas is under the Board's jurisdiction in Skagit County Cause 82-1-00152-9 for Attempted Murder in the First Degree Count I and Rape in the First Degree Count II. He has previous convictions in Skagit County Cause 3919 for Rape in the Second Degree and Whatcom County for 9191. Both Cause 3319 and 9191 have reached their statutory maximum.

The crimes in cause 82-1-00152-9 involved Mr. Rivas using a rouse to get into an unknown young woman's vehicle where he raped her at knifepoint, tied her hands and feet and pushed her car into a river. She was able to escape from the car and swim part way to shore where she was rescued by two

fisherman. Mr. Rivas was 29 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 64 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Rivas' last major infraction was in 2013 which was an assault on another inmate.

Mr. Rivas completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program as well as Aftercare and received good provider reports.

Mr. Rivas has good community support in Snohomish County to include his wife. He wants to release to transitional housing before living with his wife.

Mr. Rivas was previously found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-Entry Plan. The End of Sentence Review Committee ordered a Forensic Psychological Evaluation (FPE). The Board rescinded the previous finding of conditionally parolable, found him not parolable and added 12 months to his minimum term to await the findings in the FPE. The FPE was received in February of 2017 and Mr. Rivas did not meet criteria for civil commitment.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends finding Mr. Rivas conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-entry Plan and adds 30 months to his minimum term to allow for transition to a camp setting and work release if appropriate. Schedule .100 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
