- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Libby was seen for a .100 Hearing on November 16, 2017 at Coyote Ridge Corrections Center.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mr. Patnode presented this case.

Mr. Libby is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Lewis County Cause 83-1-00143-3 for Statutory Rape in the First Degree.

The offense included Mr. Libby sexually assaulting and torturing three known minor females with whom he had been residing as their live in babysitter. Mr. Libby was 33 or 34 at the time of the offenses and he is currently 70 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to low-moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Libby has incurred 30 serious infractions during his incarceration to include a 2017 Sexual Harassment Infraction.

Mr. Libby has not programmed or been employed since his last hearing in 2014. He has not developed a release plan, but hopes to release to his fiancée in Auburn. The Board will request Mr. Libby be assessed for the Moving Forward program within DOC.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that he be found not parolable and that sixty (60) months be added to his minimum term.
Next Action: Schedule a .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date.
