- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Wheat was seen for a .100 Hearing on November 21, 2017 at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Washington State Reformatory.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Rongen presented this case.

Mr. Wheat is under the Board's jurisdiction in King County Cause #42464 for Counts I, II and III of Murder in the First Degree. He originally received the death penalty on all three counts. He was later re-sentenced to life on each count with the possibility of parole. At the last hearing in 1998, the Board paroled Mr. Wheat from Count II to Count III. He has served 52 years in prison.

The crimes involved Mr. Wheat and a co-defendant entering gas stations with lone attendants working. They robbed the gas stations and shot the

attendants execution style. Mr. Wheat was 21 years of age at the time of the crimes and is currently 73 years old.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low risk to re-offend.

Mr. Wheat has received four serious infractions in 52 years of incarceration.

Mr. Wheat has been at the Washington State Reformatory since 1978. He is considered a stabilizing force within the prison. He is a member of the Concerned Lifer's group, he mentors young inmates and he has completed his Bachelor's Degree in Psychology while incarcerated.

Mr. Wheat would like to release to Tabernacle House in Seattle, Washington.

- **Recommendation:** The panel recommends that Mr. Wheat be found not parolable and that no time be added to his minimum term.
Next Action: Schedule .100 120 days prior to his earned release date which is currently in November of 2020.
