To a jail near you!!! T-Roc staff recently completed their MRT Training, and will begin facilitating MRT groups both in the jail and in the field offices. Currently, we have a group that meets every Monday afternoon at the Puyallup Field Office and a group that meets every Wednesday at T-Roc. We hope to have MRT groups starting soon, which will run throughout the week at T-Roc. We will also be switching our jail groups from Getting It Right to MRT, sometime during the summer.

OFFENDER QUOTES

At the completion of each group, the offenders are requested to answer 2 questions regarding their transition from jail or prison. The questions are:

1) What was the most challenging issue that you faced within your community / family / friends? How did you handle it and what was the outcome? 2) What was the most challenging issue that you faced within yourself? How did you handle it, and what was the outcome?

These are a few examples of the responses:

1) ..."Employment, still working on it. "

...death in the family " the way I handled it was just to accept it and relax. "

..."Being in DOC, having a CCO. Direct a life that is or was foul before I had an incident. "

2) ... "Staying sober. I attend AA meetings, and am still sober. "

..."The challenge that I faced was to stay away from all the bad people and staying out of trouble. "

..."Handle this situation. Just deal with it and abide by the law. "
