SOTAP Challenges

Ms. Rongen reported there continue to be COVID outbreaks in the prisons which affect those in the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP).

There are people on the waiting list for SOTAP. If an individual is amenable but has less than eight months to their earned release date (ERD), they will not be placed in SOTAP prior to their Board hearing.

The Hearing Investigators will respond to letters regarding the inability to get into treatment, and the Board will look at these on a case-by-case basis.

• **Check Ins** – Board and Staff reported on the status of their workload and their goal(s) for the week.

B. Chair Report

- The temporary Hearing Investigator position has been offered to Theresa Hinds and she has accepted. She will start on August 16, 2022.
- Ms. Rongen e-mailed a Power Point presentation to Board and Staff on the
 Correctional Leaders Immersion Program in the Norwegian Correctional Service
 dated June 12-17, 2022. The Department of Corrections (DOC) wants to make our
 system more humane and have a more holistic approach. Therefore, the Executive
 Strategy Team visited Norway to look at the difference between our system and
 Norway's. The Governor's Office, Representative Goodman, and Senator Wilson also
 attended.

C. Executive Director Reports -

- Ms. Getty thanked everyone's patience and showed her appreciation for the Hearing Investigators covering for each other.
- ISRB Policies have been submitted to the DOC Policy Office and will be out for public comment soon.
- Trauma Informed Care Training This training will be done with the University of Washington and other DOC Staff. The ISRB is going to participate, and Ms. Getty asked for a volunteer representative.

Ms. Ramsdell-Gilkey is working on the Sex Offender Policy Board Lifetime Supervision sub-committee.
