Research Requests



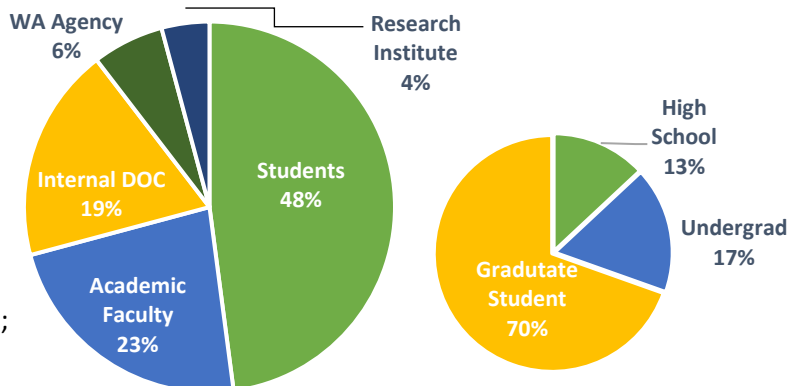

Requestor Type:

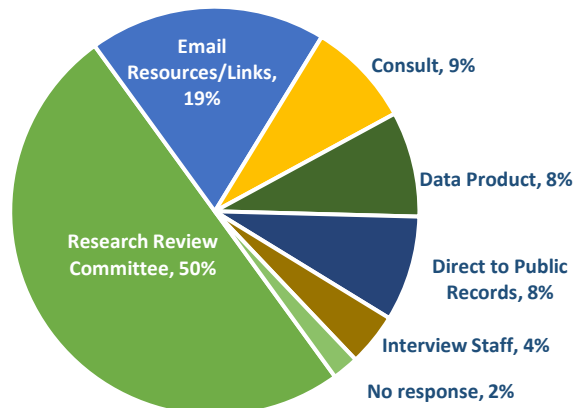
- 23 Students¹

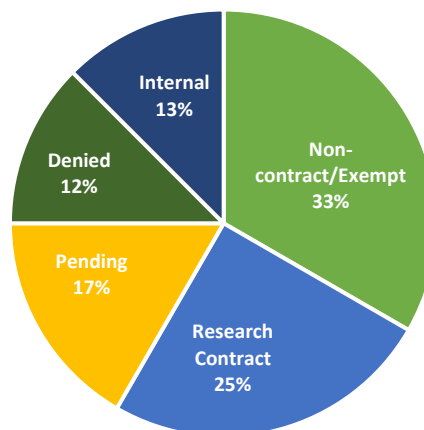

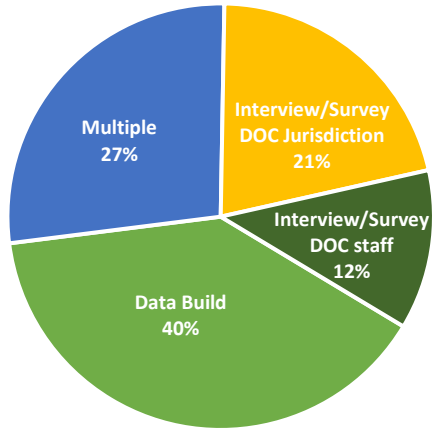

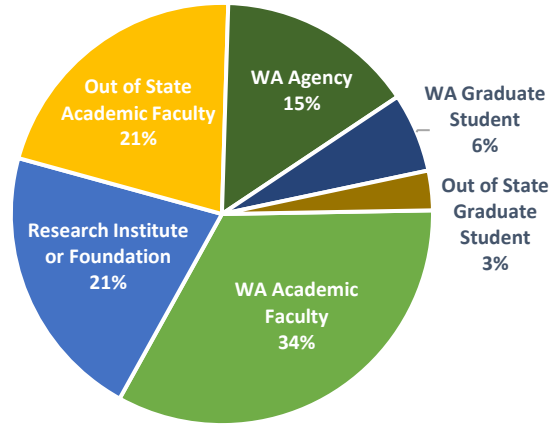
