Overview

The resource guide provided by the Tribal Relations Office contains resources for American Indians and Alaska Natives in the custody of the Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) to improve the chances of success and reduce recidivism among the population.

This guide contains four categories: **Tribal Medical Clinics and Behavioral Health Services**, **Tribal Reentry Programs**, **Tribal Vocational Rehabilitation & Education** and **Urban Indian Programs**.

Tribal Medical Clinics and Behavioral Health Services

On-reservation tribal clinics operate under federal and tribal code to serve American Indian and Alaska Natives within their service areas. Indian Health Service (IHS) service areas extend beyond tribal reservation boundaries. On-reservation behavioral health service clinics operate under tribal code and may also offer behavioral health services funded by the federal government as well as pursuant to contracts entered with the State of Washington. Tribal behavioral health service centers may offer mental health (MH), substance use disorder (SUD) or medically assisted treatment (MAT). Some tribal services serve both tribal and non-tribal clients. Please call the medical clinic or behavioral health center to see if your client is eligible for services unless otherwise indicated in this guide.

Tribal Reentry Programs

These programs provide names and contact information for tribal reentry programs intended to expand treatment options and ensure that justice, safety and recovery issues remain a consistent focus in efforts to effectively serve the needs of the members of Tribal Nations.

Tribal Vocational Rehabilitation & Education

The Washington State-Tribal American Indian Vocational Rehabilitation Programs (AIVRP) provide services to American Indians with disabilities who are seeking employment and support services. Programs also provide a wide range of services. Substance Use Disorder qualifies for services. Under Federal guidelines, programs serve all Native people residing in their service area.
