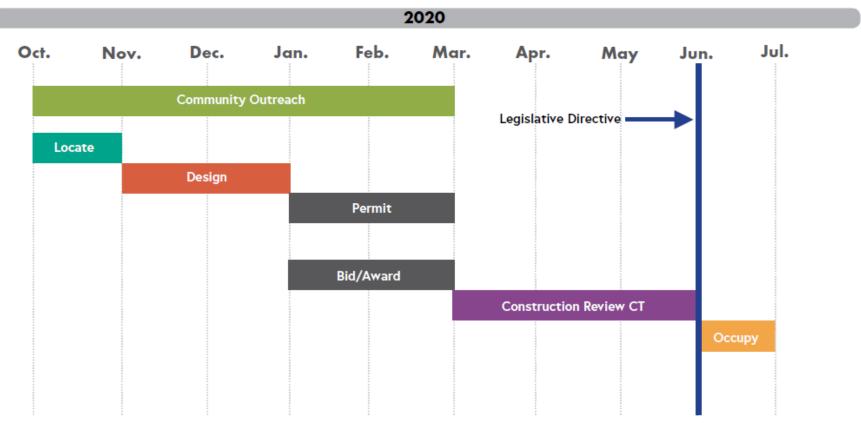

# Workplan – (50 Bed)

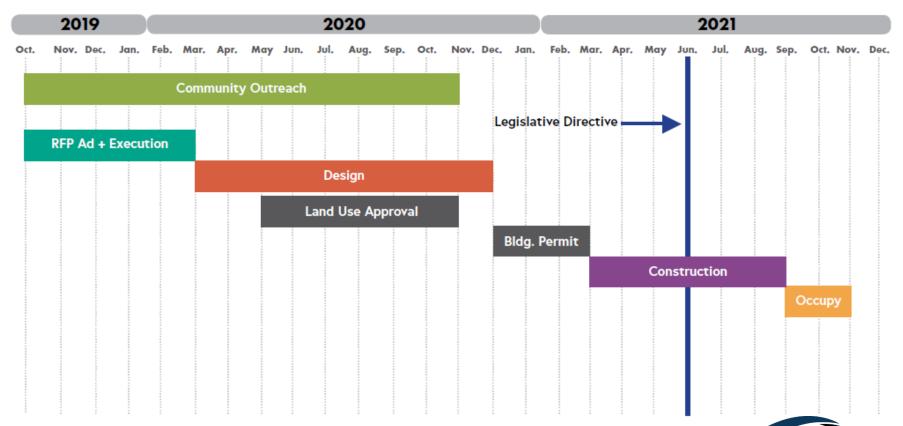
Draft Workplan - Fifty (50) Beds Work Release Expansion Legislative Directive by June 2020 (8 Months)





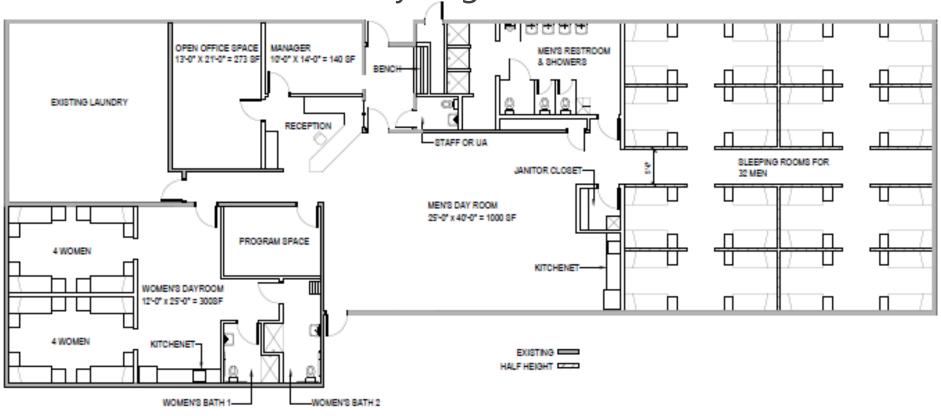
### Workplan – (150 Bed)
