Introductions and Review Contacts DOC Mission and Vision

DOC Mission: To Improve Public Safety by Positively Changing Lives DOC Vision: Working Together for Safe Communities

- Work Release Expansion
 - Work release facilities serve as a bridge between life in prison and life in the community. Incarcerated individuals who complete the work release program are more likely to be successful in maintaining employment, stable housing, and in paying legal financial obligations. Recent research conducted by the Washington State Institute for Public Policy indicates that work release programs have a positive cost/benefit impact; for every dollar spent, \$3.82 is returned to the state.



Public Hearing Timeline Review & Approval Site Status

- Wenatchee 401 Washington St. Chelan County Regional Jail Annex
 - Conditional Use Permit (CUP) not required
 - 40 beds; dormitory style layout
 - Short term (3 years) WR opportunity, then long term "other" DOC use?
 - Detox, Violators, other?
- Wenatchee 300 Okanogan Ave.
 Deaconess Building
 - CUP required
 - 82 beds; traditional layout
 - Long term WR opportunity

 - All newspapers of general circulation in the local area and all local radio stations, television stations, and cable networks;
 - Appropriate school districts, private schools, kindergartens, city and county libraries, and all other local government offices within a onehalf mile radius of the proposed site or sites;
 - The local chamber of commerce, local economic development agencies, and any other local organizations that request such notification from the department; and
 - In writing to all residents and/or property owners within a one-half mile radius of the proposed site or sites.
