Discussion	DOC presented 2 video testimonials. One featured an employer who has employed Work Release participants and shed light on the positive experience they have had. The second video featured a DOC Community Corrections Supervisor who highlighted how important Work Release is and how motivated an incarcerated individual must be to get into a Work Release program.
