SOLE SOURCE POSTING

The Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC), contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Cellebrite, Inc. to provide mobile device forensic services to DOC. DOC and Cellebrite may extend this Agreement for an additional three (3) one-year periods by written Agreement between the parties, but the three additional one-year periods will be subject to the then current rates of Cellebrite's products/services. DOC may add additional Cellebrite products or services, as necessary, at the prices quoted by Cellebrite at the time of the order, as necessary to continue to achieve the objectives of any grant(s) funding these efforts.

DOC has utilized these services during the previous year, and was once again awarded a federal grant to continue the services. DOC requires the continued services of this vendor to provide forensic services on a wide range of devices and platforms and do so in a timely manner (i.e., while the intelligence obtained is still actionable).

The mobile device forensic services industry is highly proprietary in nature, which can create difficulties when trying to mix and match providers who can only provide forensics for a subset of mobile devices, or who cannot perform the entire end-to-end service. Cellebrite is the recognized global leader in mobile device forensics and is, by a wide margin, the leading provider in the United States. This is due in part to Cellebrite proprietary advantage of supporting the widest range of Android and iOS devices and end-to-end solution.

DOC intends to enter a 1-year contract with Cellebrite on or after October 5th, 2023 (some quoted services subscriptions extending through 2028), for a total quoted cost of \$92,548.96.

By 5 PM PST October 5th, 2023, vendors who believe they are qualified to provide this service are encouraged to respond to this notice by emailing the contact listed below with the following information:

(1) Vendor qualifications and experience including:

- a. A list of current public entity clients;
- b. A list of supported mobile devices and operating systems;
- c. Experience, if any, working with correctional agencies to provide forensic services on contraband mobile devices.

(2) A cost estimate;

(3) A copy of Vendor's standard terms and conditions.
