

Special Family Friendly Visitation Events

There are three event types that are scheduled throughout the year:

- **Family Friendly:** We hold 6 family friendly events per year with reservations required. The Family Friendly Reservation message line phone number is 509-543-5974 or you can email docfamilyfriendlyres@doc1.wa.gov Reservations open 5 weeks before the event and close 2 weeks prior to the event to allow for our staff to get the needed supplies. You can also look at the event calendar for dates when reservation line is open and closed.

Family Friendly Events including Children will have the following restrictions.

- The Incarcerated Individual needs to be 90 days major infraction free
 - Incarcerated Individual's cannot attend if the DOC System states they are restricted from being around minors.
- **Cultural:** Hispanic Heritage, Black History and Asian Pacific Islanders events are held throughout the calendar year. Arrangements for family participation in diversity events is done by the incarcerated individual. There is not a reservation process in place for the families. Please talk to your loved ones if you are interested in going to one of these events.
 - **Religious:** We hold several religious events throughout the calendar year. The incarcerated individual is responsible for making arrangements for the family to participate. Their request to attend must be received by the Chaplain no fewer than 45 days prior to the event date shown.

NOTE: Debit cards are only allowed for events that do not offer food.

Attention: Family Friendly Events are not permitted until Phase 4 of the Safe Start program. Furthermore, these dates are subject to change/cancellation due to COVID-19 restriction and/or response.

To utilize this program, **please** complete the **application** below after reading the **Rules of Conduct...**

Rules of Conduct

Applicant(s) –

- ♥ Must be 18 years of age or older.
- ♥ Must have current approved visitor's status for the inmate prior to submitting their reservation for consideration and/or approval.
- ♥ Must be in the IMMEDIATE Family of the inmate. LIMITED TO ~ Father, Mother, Legal Spouse, Children (birth/legal adoption) and Grandparents. *Children ages 10 or older or more than 2 adults/room are an additional \$5.00 per night.*
- ♥ Must mail their reservation fee of \$30.00 per night with their completed application to "Room at the Inn Ministry". Payment accepted in Money Order or Cashier's Check only.
- ♥ Gives permission to the "Room at the Inn Ministry" administrator to verify the Applicant(s) visitation privileges with Coyote Ridge Corrections Center (CRCC) through the Chaplaincy office.
- ♥ Gives permission to the administrator to provide to the Motel management the applicant's contact information and redemption coupon number for reservation. Direct calls to motels ONLY TO CANCEL reservation please.
- ♥ Agrees to adhere to each individual motel's policies.
- ♥ Is held responsible for any damages incurred while a guest(s) at individual motel.

Applicant(s) understands –

- Applications must be received a minimum of three (3) weeks prior to date of request.
- Guest Rooms are subject to availability. *If we cannot accommodate your request, your payment will be returned to you in full.*
- Reservation Coupon should be presented to the assigned motel at time of Check In.
- Limit of six (6) nights per calendar year per inmate's immediate family members.
- A CANCELLATION FEE of \$10.00 per individual reservation/application will be withheld from submitted reservation fee prior to refund.
- Suspension of program privileges for Applicant(s) and or Guest(s) who choose to violate the Rules of Conduct, and motel policies including damages incurred to motel property.
