- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received. The Prosecutor does not recommend Mr. Lakey be released.
- Hershel Lakey was seen for a .100 hearing on March 18, 2025 at the Airway Heights Corrections Center.

• Summary Discussion

Corey McNally presented the case to the full Board.

• Hershel Lakey is under the jurisdiction of the Board for their conviction of Murder in the First Degree in Thurston County Cause 79-1-00082-9.

Mr. Lakey met an unknown female in a bar and later in the evening at her residence, he raped and murdered her. He was 21 years of age at the time of the crime and is currently 67 years of age.

Previous Criminal History:

Mr. Lakey's criminal history started as a juvenile in 1974. His crimes were Indecent Liberties, stealing his father's car and selling marijuana at school.

Risk assessments show him to be a low moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Lakey's last serious infraction was in 2013.

Mr. Lakey has completed several programs since being incarcerated most recently he completed SOTAP.

Mr. Lakey would like to release to Seattle using the DOC voucher program as well as utilizing his tribal support.

• Decision:

The panel recommends add 36 months to Mr. Lakey's minimum term and find him conditionally parolable to a Mutual Reentry Plan (MRP).

• Reasons:

- Mr. Lakey's last serious infraction was in 2013.
- Scores moderate risk on the Static 99R (+4 points)
- Scores high risk on the Stable 2007 (+13 points)
- Scores High Risk on the V-RAG (Bin 8 of 9)

• Recommendations:

- Sober Support Groups
- Other Programs, if eligible. Such as: Thinking for a Change, Redemption, Bridges to Life, Alternatives to Violence, Domestic Violence Treatment
- Remain infraction free and have positive interactions with staff
- Participate in next Hearing
- Develop a release plan/community support

• Next Action: Schedule a .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his PERD.
