The Board discussed developing a process to track cases that have been paroled to a consecutive cause not under the jurisdiction of the ISRB where they have a release condition to complete programming. The Board would like to know months before release whether the incarcerated individual has completed programming listed on the

Order of Release prior to release on the consecutive cause. Discussion on this issue will continue.

- Proposed legislation – Ms. Rongen reported on proposed legislation.


E. Community Concerns Meeting


