



NOTICE OF POTENTIAL WITHHOLDING AND RIGHT TO FILE PETITION

RCW 9.94A.7606(1) allows the Department of Corrections to issue any person or entity an Order to Withhold and Deliver property of any kind, including, but not restricted to, earnings that are due, owing, or belonging to an offender, if the Department has reason to believe that there is, in the possession of such person or entity, property that is due, owing, or belonging to the individual.

At this time, the Department of Corrections is issuing an Order to Withhold and Deliver against property belonging to the individual, described as:

The aforementioned property is subject to potential withholding 10 calendar days from the date you received this notice. If you should want to contest the withholding of your interest in the property, you must file a petition stating your disagreement with the Department of Corrections within 10 calendar days of your receiving this notice.
