The minutes of the Involuntary Antipsychotic Hearing Committee are included with this form. The committee met to decide if you can be given antipsychotic medications even if you do not want them.

APPEAL PROCEDURES

You can appeal if the committee decided that antipsychotic can be given. You can appeal now or later. The appeal has to be made WITHIN 24 HOURS (excluding weekends and holidays) after you get this form.

I have received a copy of the minutes of the Involuntary Antipsychotic Hearing Committee. I know that I may appeal the decision to the Director of Mental Health within 24 hours. The Director of Mental Health then decides if the committee followed the right procedure.

- I want to appeal the decision of the committee now. I know that this form and the minutes will be sent to the Director of Mental Health.
- I do not want to appeal the decision of the committee right now. I know I can still appeal in the next 24 hours. I do that by sending a kite to the Director of Mental Health.
