NON-STIGMATIZING LANGUAGE

- Person with a substance use disorder Substance abuser or drug abuser Alcoholic Addict User Abuser Drunk Junkie Addicted babies/born addicted Babies born with an opioid dependency Substance use disorder or addiction Drug habit Use, misuse Abuse • Risky, unhealthy, or heavy use Problem · Person in recovery Clean Abstinent Not drinking or taking drugs Treatment or medication for addiction Substitution or replacement therapy Medication-Assisted Treatment
- Medication for Opioid Use Disorder/Alcohol Use Disorder
- Positive, negative (toxicology screen results)
- Clean, dirty
