ORC was founded in 1979 and is located on the westside of Olympia in a traditional residential setting surrounded by apartment complexes, a city park and a church. The primary goal is to improve public safety by positively changing lives by providing consistent support, encouragement, recognition and accountability.

Residents who meet the screening criteria may be transferred to ORC 12 months before their earliest release date. The facility is operated in conjunction with a long-term non-profit partner, A Beginning Alliance, that provides 24/7 safety and security, food service and maintenance. The building is owned by the Department of Corrections.
