Current Status

• On December 26, 2020, an individual incarcerated at Airway Heights Corrections Center passed away at a local healthcare facility due to COVID-19 related illness.

Topics of Interest

Due to the ongoing response to COVID-19 and impacts to available staffing resources, temporary commissary spending limits were imposed and went into effect on <u>December 10, 2020</u>. Beginning on <u>January 11, 2021</u>, commissary spending limits will revert back to prior levels.

- Commissary operations at both Airway Heights Corrections Center (AHCC) and Monroe
 Correctional Complex are experiencing worker shortages. The temporary reduction of spending
 limits has allowed commissary operations to keep up with the demand and fulfill orders
 statewide.
- With the COVID-19 outbreak that occurred at AHCC, the commissary program experienced challenges in their purchasing department which has led to a higher than average number of out-of-stock items. We are working diligently to limit the impact and hope to have the inventory levels adjusted in the upcoming weeks.

Prison Facilities

Airway Heights Corrections Center (AHCC)

- To date, 1,432 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.
- In the coming weeks, recovered individuals will begin to move back into their original housing units and when possible their original cells.

Coyote Ridge Corrections Center (CRCC)

- To date, 353 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.
- Most of CRCC Minimum Security Unit has been returned to normal status.

Larch Correction Center (LCC)

• To date, 6 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.

Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC)

To date, 83 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.

 On 12/30/2020, Twin Rivers Unit (TRU) E unit and Washington State Reformatory Unit Old Segregation Unit were opened to function as Violator Intake Separation Units. This will allow other violator beds to be transitioned to medical isolation beds.

Stafford Creek Corrections Center (SCCC)

- To date, 900 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.
- The number of COVID-19 positive recovered individuals is increasing and they will begin to have access to the dayrooms throughout the day.

Washington Corrections Center (WCC)

• To date, 734 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.

Washington State Penitentiary (WSP)

• To date, 803 incarcerated individuals have tested positive for COVID-19.

Work Release Facilities

Ahtanum View Work Release

• To date, 3 residents have tested positive for COVID-19.

Peninsula Work Release

• To date, 2 residents has tested positive for COVID-19.
