Current Status

Per Secretary Sinclair's previous <u>Mandatory Use of Surgical Masks</u> memo sent on November 6, 2020, the department enhanced personal protective equipment (PPE) measures and implemented mandatory wearing of surgical masks for all departmental staff, contract staff and persons entering all department locations:

 The <u>requirement has been extended</u> and will remain in place through February 28, 2021 and all department locations will continue to provide surgical masks for usage by staff, contractors and others entering department locations.

Topic of Interest

The <u>COVID Prison Project</u> tracks data and policy across the country to monitor COVID-19 in correctional facilities. As compared with reporting from all 50 state correctional agencies, WA Corrections' ranks:

- 18th out of 50 states for <u>number of positive cases</u>
- 19th out of 50 states for cases as a percentage of the population
- 43rd out of 50 states for mortality rate among incarcerated individuals

Prison Facilities

Airway Heights Corrections Center (AHCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 633
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 1,504
- Reminder sent to staff and incarcerated individuals in regards to following COVID-19 protocols.
- The facility continues to clean, sanitize and disinfect areas between cohort use. This includes the sanitization of all surfaces, phones, KIOSK/JPay keyboards, and microwaves.
- Restricted movement at the Minimum Security Unit will be lifted tomorrow, January 16, 2021.

Coyote Ridge Corrections Center (CRCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 6
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 354
- As of January 14, 2021, CRCC is in outbreak status.

Larch Correction Center (LCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 280
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 280

Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 248
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 317
- A 30-bed Rapid Deployment Care Facility (RDCF) has been setup at the Twin Rivers Unit (TRU) for utilization as an alternate housing area for COVID-19 positive individuals that require enhanced medical care. (see photo gallery)
