Current Status

- There are three (3) prison facilities currently in outbreak status, compared to seven (7) prisons in outbreak status on January 25, 2021.
- There are currently 64 total active COVID-19 cases in the incarcerated population, compared to 835 active incarcerated cases on January 25, 2021.

Prison Facilities

Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 146
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 546
- The facility is currently experiencing technical issues with the incarcerated individual's phone system and they are not able to make outgoing calls at this time. The service provider has been notified and is working on the issue.

Stafford Creek Corrections Center (SCCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 116
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 1,200

Washington Corrections Center (WCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 44
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 975
- Incarcerated individuals who are not on quarantine or medical isolation status continue to have opportunities for recreation within cohort groups.
