Current Status

 As of Tuesday, March 2, 2021, Corrections had administered 3,447 initiating vaccinations and 2,001 second vaccinations for a total of 5,448 vaccinations administered to staff and incarcerated individuals. Monroe Correctional Complex (MCC)

- The Rapid Deployment Care Facility (RCDF) at the Twin Rivers Unit is not currently housing COVID-19 positive individuals and will be closed until needed.

Stafford Creek Corrections Center (SCCC)

- Number of new cases in last 30 days: 55
- Number of confirmed cases to date: 1,203
- The alternate housing area located in the visit room is no longer needed to house COVID-19 positive individuals and will be closed until needed.
- G unit A tier remains on quarantine status.
