Current Status

- There are two (2) prison facilities and two (2) work release facilities currently in outbreak status, compared to six (6) prisons and two (2) work release facilities in outbreak status on January 5, 2021.
- There are currently 33 total active COVID-19 cases in the incarcerated population, compared to 1,560 active incarcerated cases on January 5, 2021.
