As COVID-19 positive case rates have continued to decrease in facilities across the state and
there are now no prison and work release facilities on outbreak status, there are a reduced
amount of related changes. Beginning March 24, 2021, the Corrections' COVID-19 Bulletin will
reduce publications to once a week on Wednesdays, until further notice. The COVID-19
Significant Event Timeline will continue to be updated regularly.
