## **Current Status**

The Washington State Department of Corrections continues to evaluate its response to COVID-19 and remains focused on mitigating the spread of COVID-19 by continuing to follow appropriate science-based protocols to ensure the health and safety of those in its custody and its staff.

- 14,314 March 2021 Total <u>Average Daily Population</u> of Incarcerated Individuals for Prison and Work Release Facilities
- 11 Total Active Incarcerated Cases
- **6,215** Total Recovered Incarcerated Cases
- 7,363 Incarcerated Individuals have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
- 3,693 Staff\* have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
