Current Status

The Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) is saddened by the loss of Correctional Officer Gabe Forrest, who passed away on Thursday, June 17, 2021 from complications of COVID-19.

Consistent with the <u>Health Emergency Labor Standards Act (HELSA) (pdf)</u>, the Department is proceeding on the presumption that his death was work-related. The Department of Corrections and <u>Behind the Badge Foundation</u>, along with other agencies have come together to help plan a memorial that is consistent with the families wishes.
