## **Current Status**

The Department of Corrections continues to be focused on mitigating the transmission of COVID-19 and regularly reviews and updates its protocols based on guidance from the Washington State Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control.

- **1,637** Total Staff Cases to Date
- **13,475** May 2021 Total <u>Average Daily Population</u> of Incarcerated Individuals for Prison and Work Release Facilities
- **45** Total Active Incarcerated Cases
- 6,321 Total Recovered Incarcerated Cases
- 8,857 Incarcerated Individuals have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
- 3,779 Staff\* have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
- 19th out of 50 states for number of positive cases (Data from covidprisonproject.com)
- **21st** out of 50 states for <u>cases as a percentage of the population</u> (Data from covidprisonproject.com)
