### Question 1

What is the total population at MCCCW?

Answer

As of today, there are 196 incarcerated individuals at MCCCW.

UNIT BREAKDOWN: Mission Creek Unit - 79 individuals -- 58 upstairs in unit/with an additional 20 housed in Visitation Alternate Housing (VAH);  
Bear Creek Unit - 53 individuals; AND  
Gold Creek Unit - 62 individuals

### Question 2

Why is the KIOSK down?

Answer

A significant agency wide issue requiring the system, as a whole, be taken off line has happened. System may be back up and running by the end of this week.

### Question 3

What is the status on the hot water?

Answer

We have reached out to a contractor. There is an approved Purchase Order and we are hoping the system will be fixed by end of June.

### Question 4

How extensive is your Health Services Clinic at MCCCW?

Answer

We have a Physician's Assistant and Registered Nurse on staff at MCCCW. Just no 24/7 access to a Clinic. The Health Care Manager, who supervises WCCW and MCCCW, come to MCCCW once a week.

### Question 5

What happens when an individual needs dental or vision care?

#### Answer

Individuals' kiosk MCCCW Health Care and they make arrangements for individual to see Specialists at WCCW or make the appointment directly in the community.
