

## MINIMUM CONTACT STANDARDS

Minimum contact standards will follow the individual's Contact Risk Level Classification (RLC) or Sex Offense Risk Category, whichever is higher, except as specified below.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individuals classified Moderate Risk</li> <li>• The following individuals classified Low/Lower Risk:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Has sex offense risk category of Moderate or Low Moderate</li> <li>○ Required to register on an active cause</li> <li>○ Reentry Community Services Program participants</li> <li>○ Has court ordered mental health treatment</li> <li>○ Scores High Need in the mental health domain of the risk and needs assessment</li> <li>○ Individuals with a current Drug Sentencing Alternative or Mental Health Sentencing Alternative cause(s)</li> <li>○ All other Juvenile Board individuals and individuals sentenced PAR</li> <li>○ Individuals on supervision under a Governor's conditional commutation order unless the order specifies more frequent contact</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 face-to-face contacts per quarter</li> <li>• 1 collateral contact per month</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All other individuals classified Low/Lower Risk, unless otherwise specified in these standards</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Report using CeField if arrested or when the address, phone number, employment, contact person, and/or contact person's phone number changes</li> </ul>

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individuals in a period of reintegration supervision per DOC 380.210 Community Reintegration</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 face-to-face contacts in a 30 day period</li> <li>• 2 collateral contacts in a 30 day period</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individuals who do not yet have a Contact RLC established</li> <li>• Individuals with a current Drug Sentencing Alternative cause(s) who have not yet entered treatment</li> <li>• From Out-of-State individuals arriving in Washington State on approved Reporting Instructions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 face-to-face contact per week</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individuals in inpatient treatment, regardless of risk level, sentence type, or reintegration status</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 collateral contact per month</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Homeless individuals, except Low Risk not required to register</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 face-to-face contact per week</li> <li>• 1 collateral contact per month</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individuals on active LRA per DOC 380.350 Less Restrictive Alternatives:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Not guilty by reason of insanity</li> <li>○ Special finding of violent felony</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Per the plan developed by the transition team</li> </ul>
